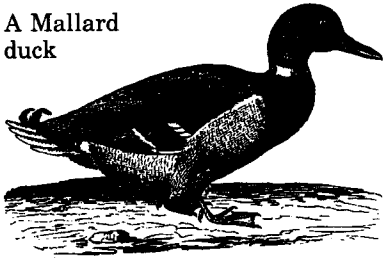


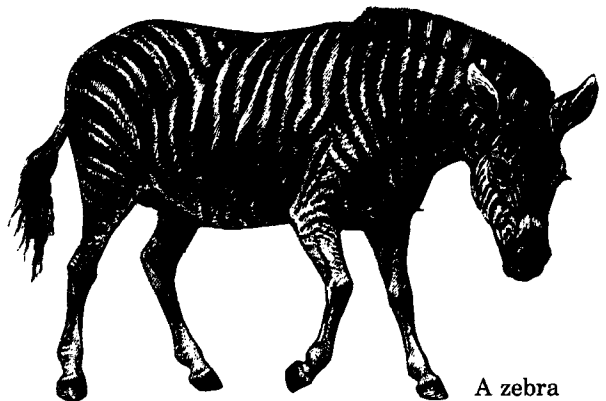

LIST 2-33. ANIMALS THAT MIGRATE

Many animals periodically travel a long route and return to their point of origin or migrate over long distances in search of food, water, shelter, warmer weather, a place to mate, or a place to lay eggs or raise young. Destruction of any part of the migratory route threatens the existence of the species. Examples of animals that migrate:
