This program visually demonstrates the effects of pollution on streams and the living things in the stream, namely Freddie the Fish. Students listen to a story as Freddie travels on a journey downstream, while they witness the pollution being dumped into his environment. Students are asked how Freddie might feel, and come to realize that the pollution can all add up and impact our environment. This is a great program for younger students, and can be tailored to cover specific topics.
