**Helpful Hints:** For Molds: use plaster paris (two parts) to one part water. Use small plastic food bags, put in plaster paris & water. Then use hands to “squeeze & squash” the mixture. When ready, snip the corner & squeeze the mixture out and cover the entire mold to the edge. Wait for mixture to set-up (time depends on weather) & gently remove rubber molding. Clean & rinse mold, and use again!
