



## **“TREE TRUNK” – Teacher’s Educational Trunk** **Inventory of Materials:**

### *Miscellaneous*

1. **Leaf Replicas** – a variety of rubber leaf replicas that can be used for art work – with paint or ink & then used with a roller. Great for art projects or just leaf identification. Leaves included are: Fern, Aspen, Basswood, Red Oak, Tulip, Ash, Elm, Ginkgo, & White Oak.
2. **10 (8.5 x 11) Mini Posters** from International Paper about Trees, Forestry & Environmental Issues
3. **8 Small Tree Rounds** (called “cookies”) for students to look at & touch.
