- **How does it work?**
- Around the room are “People with Posters.” Each poster represents a category from our annual plan of work: Ag Assistance, Urban Assistance, Public Outreach and Education, Administrative Program Assistance, and Coordinated Projects with Conservation Agencies.
- Alongside the posters are staff members that specialize in that area of work to answer questions.
- Participants may visit any or all of these stations to learn, ask questions or make suggestions. These visits can inform your response to the questionnaire.
